

2022 Democracy Checkup Survey Codebook

Survey Weights

The data have been weighted using an iterative "raking" process, as provided by the ipfraking command in STATA15. Marginal values were successively weighted according to province (with Quebec divided by language), as well as gender and age group, based on the 2016 and 2021¹ Canadian Census. Language division in Quebec was based on the 2016 Canadian Census since language data from the 2021 census was not released at the time of weighting². A maximum of 200 iterations were completed. This weight is contained in the variable

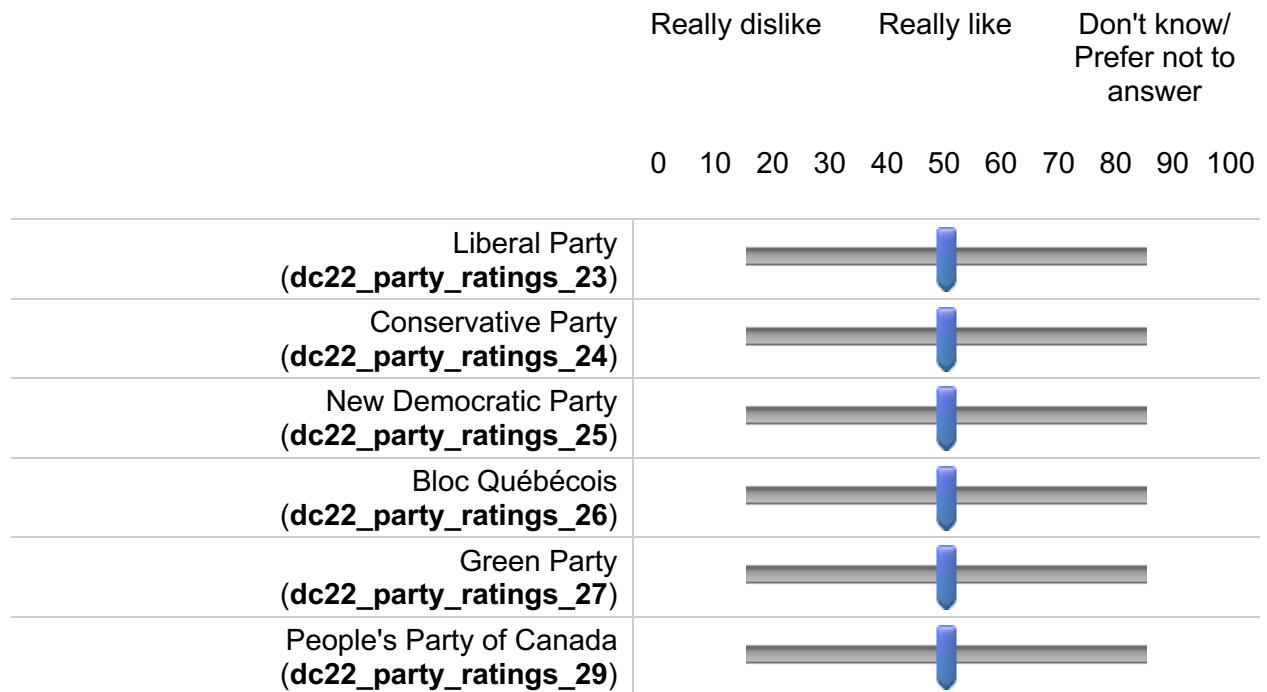

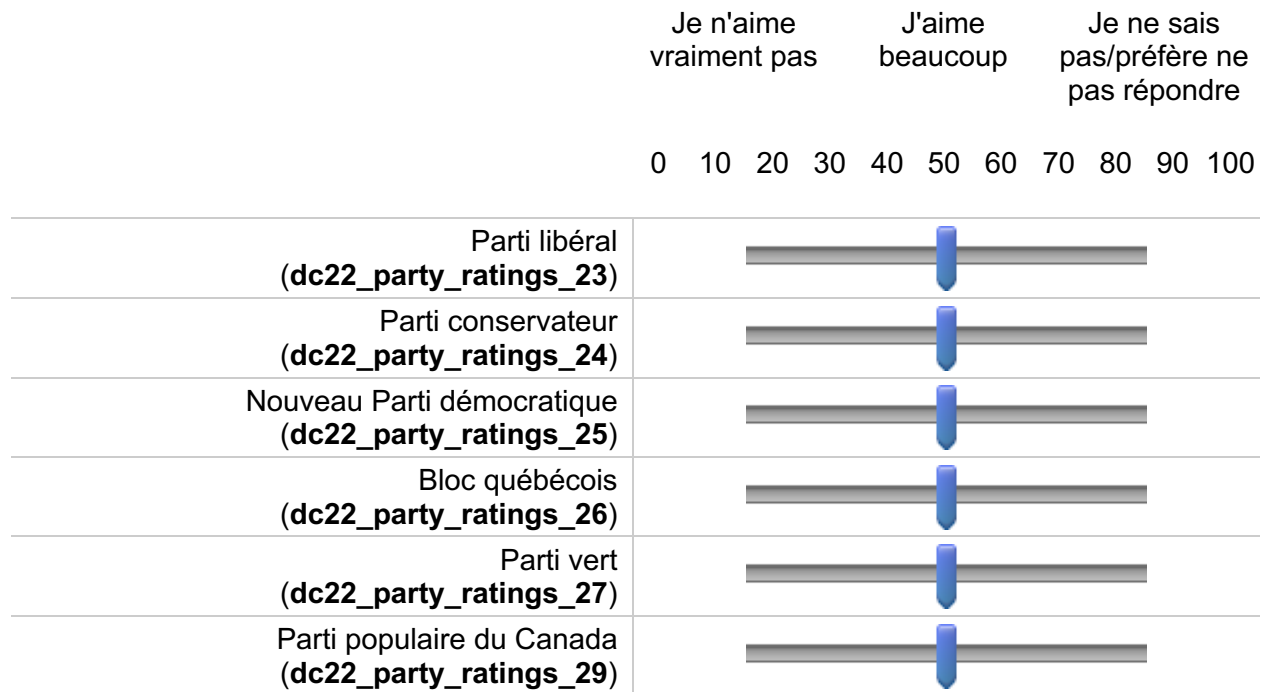

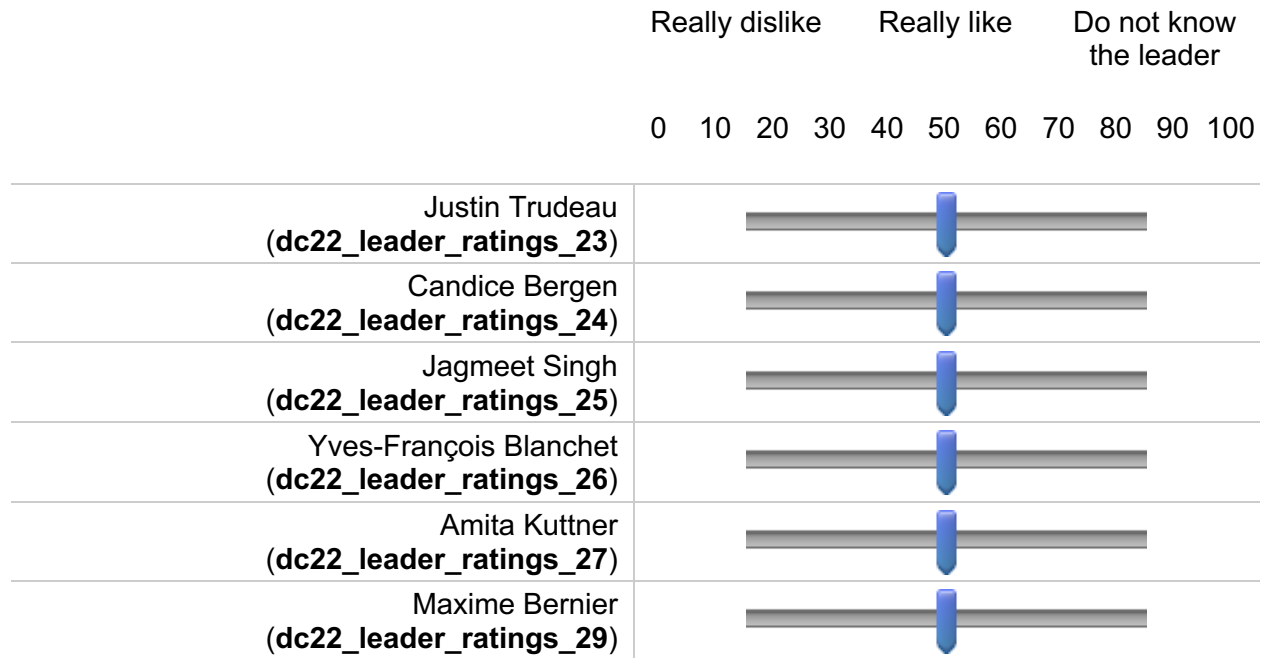

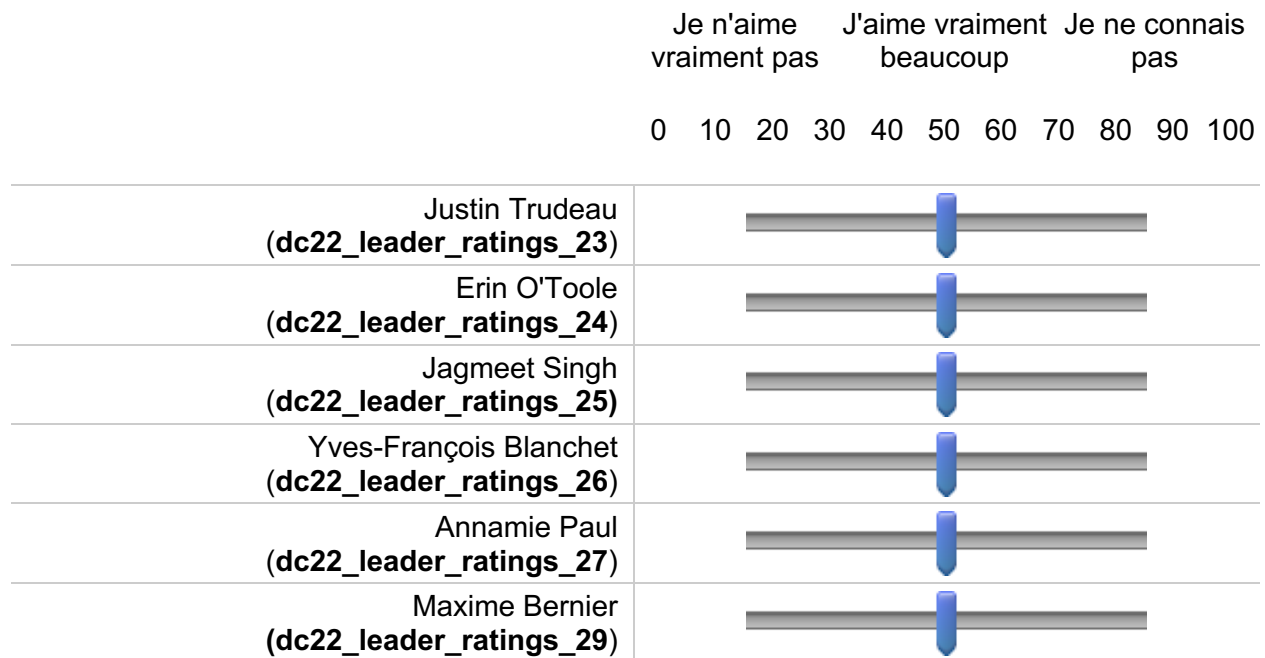
Start of Block: Leader ratings

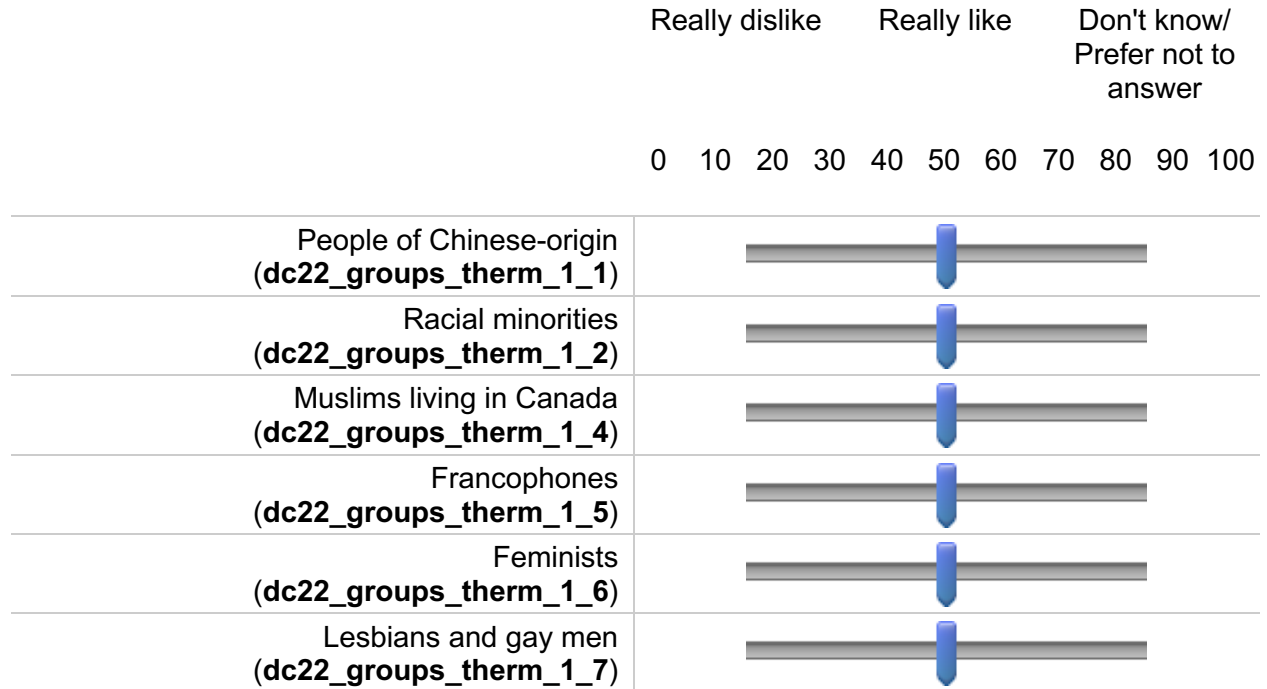

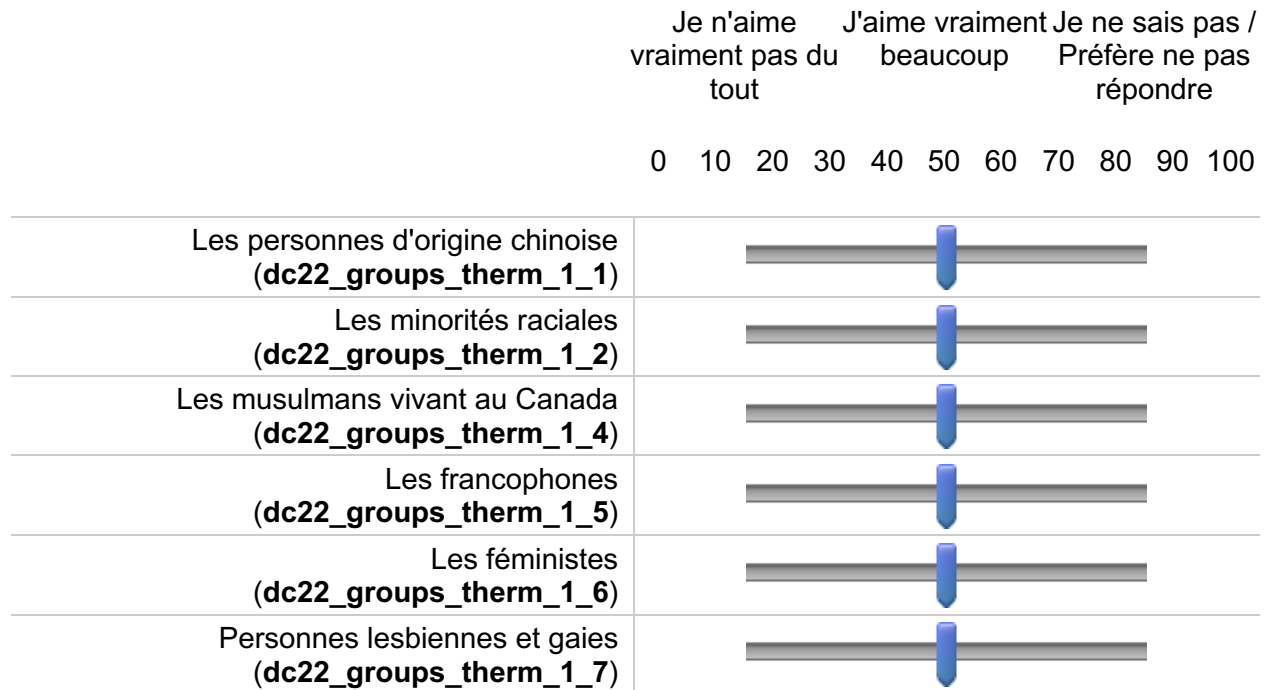

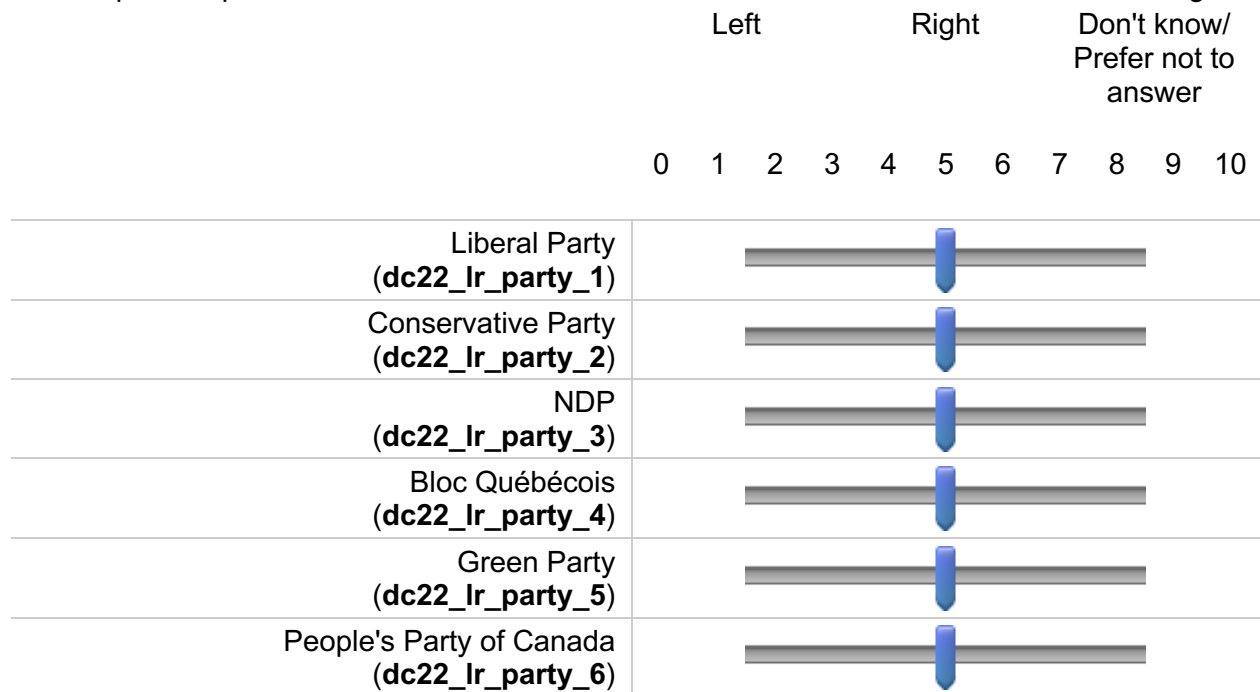

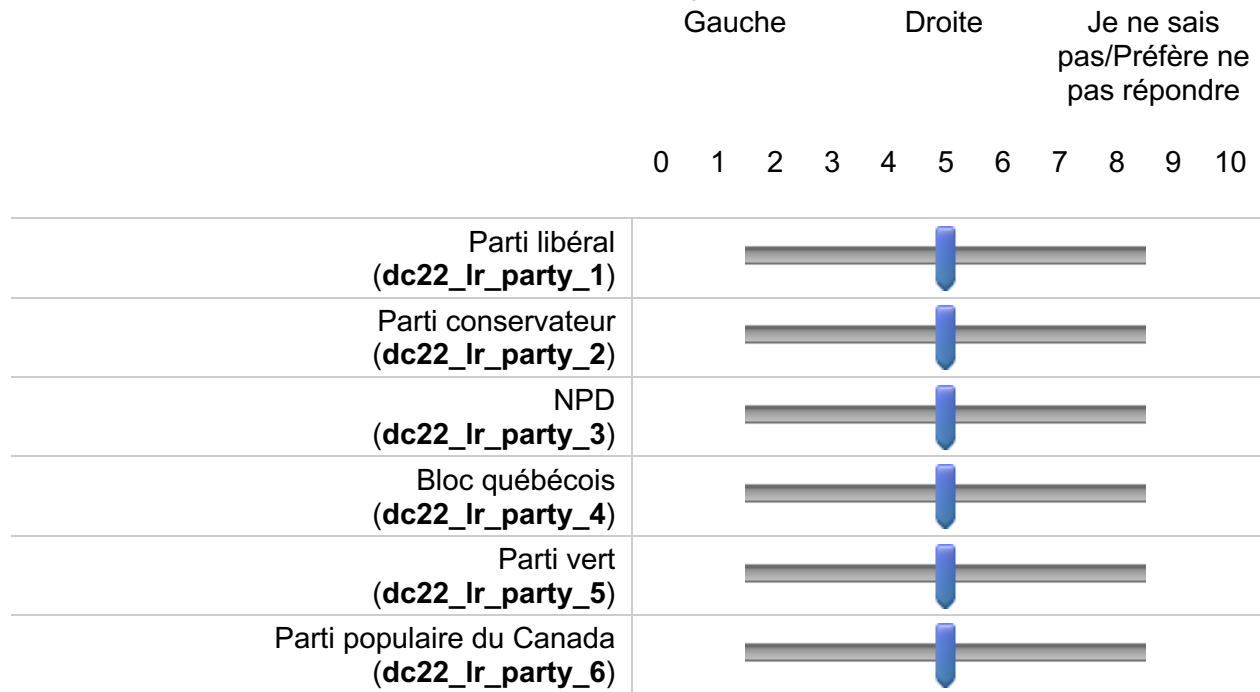
